Easy Reference to determine the size canopy/tent needed for any size group

When planning for a tent, the ground must be relatively flat. Over-head wires, tree limbs, etc. must not interfere with the tent. Tent stakes and ropes should not be placed near stairs and walkways unless they are clearly marked with vertical posts. Site inspection is required before reserving a tent/canopy. Fire Permits are required on any structures over 400sq. feet.

Fifteen (15) sq. ft. per person required for dining under canopy.

Seven (7) sq. ft. per person required for theater-style seating.
